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Small Brother Is Watching You

E-readers are devices that you can use to read e-books or e-magazines. They have become very popular because they have many advantages: they are small and can hold thousands of e-books, so you can carry your complete library around with you at all times. Some of them can also play sound and video, making your reading experience more attractive than reading a paper book. We do not think about it, but the devices are already changing the way we read.

Some e-readers can observe your reactions when you read. They can check how fast you read, which parts of the text you read more than once and which parts you ignore. Basically, your e-reader knows when you enjoy reading, what makes you bored and what makes you smile. A bit scary, isn't it?


All this information is then stored and analysed by computers. It can be used by publishers for marketing, but it can also be used to make e-books more personal. It's not possible yet, but maybe the next step will be e-books that adapt to our individual preferences? If you don't like long descriptions of nature, for example, your e-reader will remove them so you will not have to read them at all. Or if the device can see that you have stopped reading because of a difficult word, it will automatically give you its explanation or translation. And if you like happy endings, the books you read will always end well.

Some people say that teenagers hate reading long texts because they can't concentrate. The e-readers of the future might change all that by making books simpler and shorter. The question is, however, if this is what we really want? What do you think?

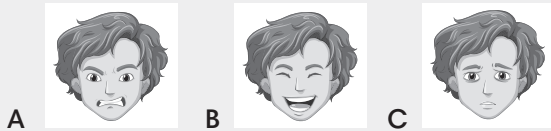
