- Time isn't the same around the world. We live on a ¹ **globe** / **circle** with different time ² **days** / **zones**. For example, when it's day in Hong Kong, it's night in New York. When there's sun in New Zealand, it's dark in the U.K. Often these places are in a different ³ **day** / **week**, too.
- This is because the **4 Earth** / **Moon** makes half a full turn every 12 hours. This means New York sees its new day 12 hours after Hong Kong. There are often different **5 time** / **night** zones in the same country, too, such as in Russia or in the U.S.A. The U.S.A. has got four **6 different** / **big** time zones.
- For example, when it's 10:30 a.m. for Kara in California, she's in class. She's had breakfast, so she isn't hungry yet. But John in Montana is getting hungry because it's 11:30 a.m. He wants his 'breakfast / lunch soon! It's already lunch time for Maria in Texas, where it's 12:30 p.m. And lunch is finished for Manuel, because the time in New York is 1:30 p.m.
