You first need to choose which class you will test.







Choose whether this is an online test or a paper test.


Creating a paper test will create a pdf that you can print off and distribute.

Give the test a name so your students and you can easily identify it.

Then choose:

- the activities to test,
- when to run the test,
- the students to take the test.

You can also add instructions.




Open the Test Generator menu to select the activities you want to include in the test.

Ensure each student gets a test with the questions in a different order to reduce potential cheating.

If you are generating a paper test, you can randomize up to five test papers.




Once you are ready, click *Save test*. The test will be assigned to students and they can open it as per the time slot chosen.
